*Meeting Minute  
February 13, 2007*

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:13pm

MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE:

Tom Reynolds, Joe Fiala, Valerie King, Chuck Metcalf, John Nikkais, and Gene Propper

SENIOR CITIZEN UPDATE (with Dot O'Neil):

- 14 seniors attended the brown bag lunch on 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday of the month.
- Interested in having a speaker come to the April meeting to discuss healthcare.
- Procedure for having March meeting expenses paid: Wearites will obtain an invoice from the story teller (Cora) and submit to town for payment. Tom Reynolds will check with Colburn's store regarding payment of refreshments.

CHASE PARK:

- Update from Kathy Robichaud-
  - Need to wait on final budget before solidifying plans regarding when to open and how many staff to hire.
  - Last year there were 13 staff (including Kathy)—9 teens (5 of which were lifeguard trained) and 4 adults (none of which are lifeguard trained). 5 of the teens were alternates (had fewer hours than the others)
  - Manchester Red Cross lifeguard training will be in April/May and will cost \$175 per student. Kathy will call back in March when training dates are set.
  - New regulation this year—all lifeguards must be at least 16 years old.
  - Kathy will call last year's staff to see who is interested in coming back and how many of those have lifeguard training. She will also check file to see which ones will need re-certifications.
  - Red Cross does not recognize CPR training taken at Weare Rescue.
- Gene given permission to move picnic tables during Radar Run. They will be returned to the pavilion following the event.
- Large portion of grass/sod planted at the beach has been dug up and ruined by what appears to be ATVs. Adults in trucks were seen unloading 4-wheelers at the beach. Gene will contact ATV club about getting signs to post the grass area. ATVs will be allowed to access the lake by way of the boat ramp, but will be prohibited from other areas of the park in an effort to minimize damage.

*Chuck moved to post the entire park (except boat ramp) with no ATVs (4-wheelers, 3-wheelers, dirt bikes) or motor bikes. John seconded the motion*

REVIEW OF MINUTES:

*Tom moved to accept the minutes for the January 9th, 2007 meeting. Chuck seconded the motion. Motion carried.*

**BOLTON FILED DEVELOPMENT:**

- Bolton Field proposals were handed out. Members were asked to review and be prepared to discuss at the next meeting.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- Discussion regarding warrant article for tennis courts. Where is the money coming from? As of 12/18/06, the Capital Reserve Fund has \$32,473.37 designated for ball fields, \$28,105.17 for Chase Park and only \$1,357.45 for tennis courts.
- Posting notice on Cable regarding search for new PARC members: Using cable website to post notices has been unsuccessful (2 attempts made). Valerie will mail written request to Cable Committee.
- Joe has asked the Town Administrator (Fred) to post the Director's job opening on Cable. It should be posted on Channel 6 sometime this week.
