*Meeting Minute
June 20, 2006*

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 5:00pm at Ineson Field

MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE:

John Nikkais, Valerie King, Chuck Metcalf, Gene Propper, Jim Blouin and Joe Fiala
Carl Knapp (Highway Department) was also present to provide his opinion as to how much prep work would be required by his workers for each of the proposed locations.

DISCUSSION REGARDING THE TEMPORARY LOCATION OF THE SKATEBOARD PARK AT INESON FIELD:

- Possible areas to locate the skateboard park were considered and discussed.
- The right parking area was determined to be the best area to locate the skateboard park as it would not remove “green space”, required little prep work (one day) and the concrete pad could have a second life as parking and/or a basketball court once the skateboard park is gone. Carl marked a 100’ x 50’ area to indicate this proposed site. Pushing the pad further up and to the right (towards property line/stone wall), was considered, but was rejected as it would required slightly more prep work.
- WAC will be contacted regarding the possibility of moving the sheds to allow additional parking in this area.
- Carl Knapp offered to have his men dump the dirt they collect from roadside work down the banking to eventually enlarge the parking area.
- Carl also offered to find someone who could perform the paving work, and will ask the potential donor if he is still willing to pay for this work (as was offered when the skateboard park was being considered for Bolton Field)
- Jim Blouin made a suggestion that unused fencing (left over from WAC project) could be used to enclose the skateboard park to keep cars off this area.
- As part of the prep work, Carl will have his men clear some of the brush and small trees in an effort to make this area more visible from the road.
- If all goes as planned, the skateboard park is expected to be ready by the beginning of the school year.

Chuck Metcalf moved to “locate the temporary skateboard park in the area marked out by Carl” Gene Propper seconded the motion. John Nikkais opposed. All others were in favor of the motion. Motion approved.
